I hereby certify that all available translations of the ASAS Health Index (ASAS HI)^{1, 2} and the Environmental Item Set (EF Item Set)^{2, 3} have been conducted according to published recommendations. The forward-backward translation has been used to translate the items of the ASAS HI and the EF Item Set according to Beaton et al.⁴. The translated version have been tested in regard to face and content validity in a field test in each country. The translation process have been overlooked at each stage by ASAS.
